All of these aspects are recognizable and possible to realize through experientially understanding how each of them has been distorted through historical conditioning.

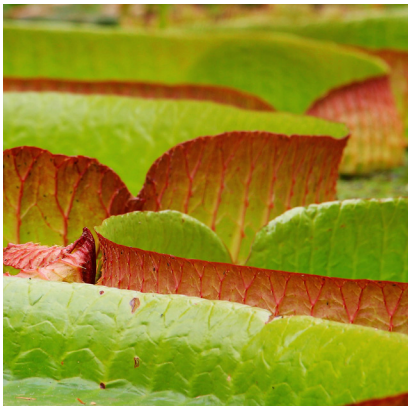
