



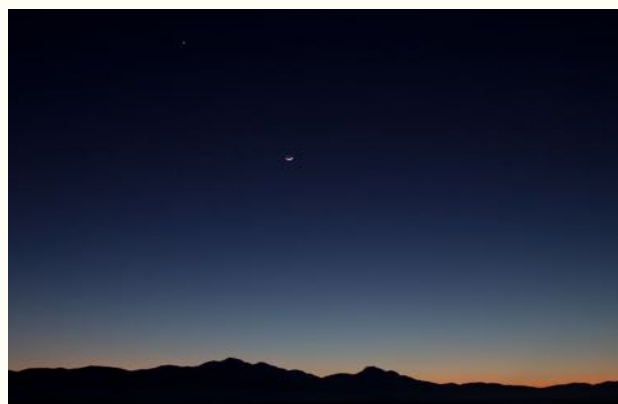
THE POWER OF SILENT INQUIRY:
